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Sermon Questions

1. Take some time to read Luke 7:36-50 as a group.
2. When is a time that you've been profoundly grateful for something? How can we sustain a posture of gratitude to God without forcing it or faking it?
3. There's value in seeing ourselves as spiritually bankrupt before God. How do we maintain that attitude while avoiding an unnecessarily negative self-image?
4. What are the characteristics of the typical Pharisee that we see in this text and other parts of the Gospels? How can we avoid following Pharisaic patterns?
5. Go around the group and share one thing for which you're feeling particularly grateful to God today. Now share one need that you are approaching God with today.
6. Take some time giving thanks to God for all that he's given you, and pray for the needs that your group has.
