Sermon Questions

1. Read out loud together 2 Kings 22:1-11 and 2 Kings 23:1-3. What do we learn about Josiah in these verses?
2. Why do you think “victimhood” is so prevalent in our culture? What are some practical ways to evaluate our own lives to make sure we don’t fall into that trap? How does Josiah not play the victim of his own circumstances?
3. What are some of the ways that the people of Judah had neglected the Book of the Law? In what ways can the Word of God be “lost” in the church or in our lives? Do you think that is a concern in the modern Christian community and what does that look like?
4. Share some of the things that you’ve done in your life to develop some discipleship habits so that you don’t neglect the Word of God or your relationship with God.
5. Why is the Bible so important for the faith and practice of the Christian life? What should a Christian believe about the authority and application of God’s Word?
